NEW BUSINESS:

New Business, Agenda Item 1, "MTU/KRC Lot 11 Purchase Agreement and Building Request". Pursuant to Section 5, Resale Rights of the Airpark Covenants MTU/KRC is requesting permission to purchase Lot 11 located in the Airpark from Bay Engineering. They also requested permission to construct a 20,000 sq ft building on the property in the back of the lot adjacent to the existing building. The plans for the 20,000 sq ft building were previously approved at the December 28, 2023 Airport Committee meeting. The change in location is due to the FAA 90 day requirement to meet all FAA compliance items to build on airport land. MTU/KRC has entered into a purchase agreement with Bay Engineering contingent upon Airport Committee approval. The Airport Manager proposed a motion to approve both requests, with the condition that Bay Engineering clears the dirt that has been stockpiled on top of the 30-foot sewer line easement. Once the dirt is removed, the sale and building can proceed as approved.

New Business, Agenda Item 4, "Mead & Hunt Monthly Progress Report". – The Mead & Hunt progress report summarizing activities for the period from March 1, 2024, through March 31, 2024 was presented for Committee review.

New Business Agenda Item 5, "Water/Sewage Report." – For the period from March 15, 2024, to April 12, 2024 (28 days) daily I&I was 8,330 gallons. For the same time period in 2023, I&I was 8,253 gallons. For the period from March 15, 2024, to April 12, 2024 (28 days) water loss was (133,902) gallons. For the same time period in 2023 water loss was (88,228) gallons.

New Business Agenda Item 6, "Airline Monthly Statistics." – For the month of March 2024, SkyWest enplaned 1,945 passengers and deplaned 2,002. Last year in March SkyWest enplanements were 2,166 compared to this year's enplanements of 1,945 a decrease of 221 passengers or 10%. SkyWest experienced 2 cancellations during the month compared to 4 in March of 2023.
